Instructions: The application package must be complete and compiled in the order described below. *All original transcripts, letters of recommendations and other required documents must have a postmark of January 15, 2017 and be received by the state chairman in a single package as described.* If your school requires that any documents be sent to another person, the applicant must arrange for the sponsoring chapter to receive the documents and the chapter will then forward them with the application in one package, to the state chairman before the deadline. Applications and statements must be typewritten. This scholarship is judged and awarded without regard to gender, race, color, religion, national origin or disability. The Scholarship MUST be used within one year of award or it will be forfeited. A student applying for this scholarship must

- 1) Scholarship Application
- 2) The Nash Music Scholarship Committee requires a Financial Need Form. In the event two candidates are equally qualified, the student with the most need will be chosen as the recipient.
- 3) Applicant must prepare a statement of 600 words or less explaining his/her career goals, specifying how their major or proposed major relates to future professional goals and reasons for these choices.
- 4) Original transcript of high school or college grades (as applicable). Original high school transcripts must indicate class rank/class size and test scores, unless home schooled. Home-schooled students should include grade transcripts for grade 9 through the current year.
- 5) List: extra-curricular activities, scholastic achievements, honors or other notable accomplishments. Maximum 2 pages.
- 6) Letters of recommendations from at least four persons in authority from the high school or college the applicant now attends who are familiar with the applicant's work. Letter may include the applicant's ability, work habits, integrity, character, potential and volunteer activities.
- 7) Photocopy of United States Citizenship: photocopy of birth certificate, naturalization papers or information page of US Passport.
- 8) Application package should be stapled or paper clipped in the top, left hand corner. Number of pages per package must not exceed 15.
- 9) Music Scholarship Applicants must include a CD or DVD of a performance. It should include three numbers of varying styles. Please list or announce each selections' name and composer. Be sure the CD/DVD can be played on a standard player or personal computer.
- 10) It is the responsibility of the applicant to give the correct and complete address for the college/university department to receive and credit the scholarship funds awarded.

In order for the Music Scholarship Chairman to acknowledge receipt of your application you must include a self-addressed, stamped postcard. **ONLY THE WINNER** is notified of judges' decision. At this time, applicants notified of a pending scholarship award will be required to submit their social security number.
