David L. Huck joined the Marine Corps in 1964 and served until 1968. His places of service included Camp Pendleton, Viet Nam, Vienna, Austria, and Camp LeJeune, North Carolina. While serving in Viet Nam as a fire-team leader in 1965, he was wounded and received the Purple Heart. He was cleared Top Secret with the Department of Naval Intelligence and was a U.S. Embassy guard in Austria in 1966-1967.

- ◇ Presidential Unit Citation
