After leaving the Army, he worked for General Motors in St. Louis, Missouri; Indiana; and Flint, Michigan. Service related illness forced him to retire.

He married Marclla Smith, and they have four children. His daughter, Clarissa, is a member of Poplar Bluff Chapter, NSDAR.

James is a member of the Sour Dough Chapter Sons of the American Revolution in Montana, and the Lutheran Church. One of his hobbies is hunting.
