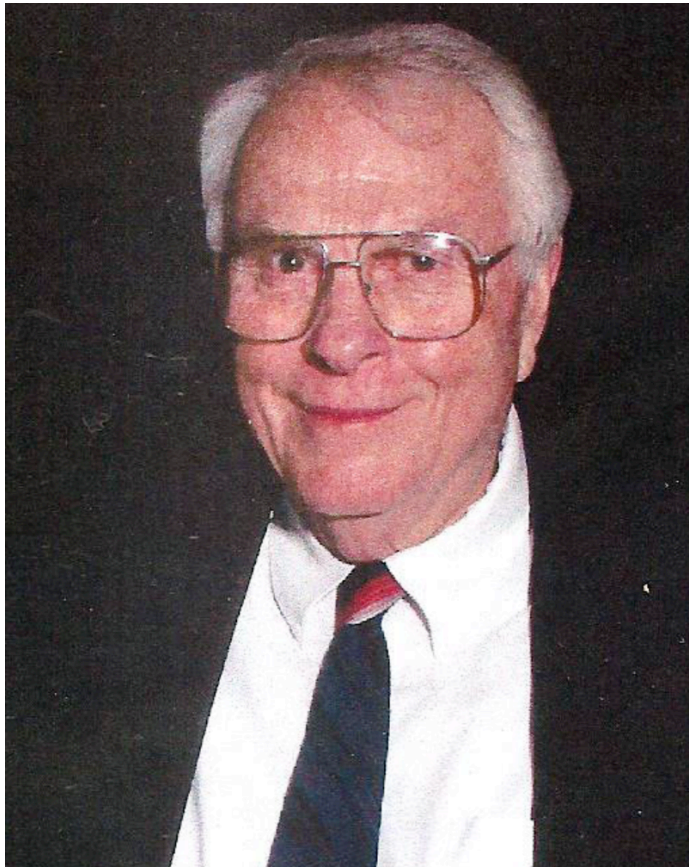




**Missouri State Society Daughters of the American Revolution
