Mr. Thomas Fischer served for three years in the U.S. Marine Corps. Tom entered the Marine Corps in St. Louis, Missouri, in October 1966 and achieved the rank of corporal during his service. He was stationed in Southeast Asia and was assigned to Infantry and Weapons Security. During his service, he was awarded the following awards and citations: Vietnam Service, Vietnam Campaign, Presidential Unit Citation, Navy Unit Commendation, and the Vietnamese Gallantry Cross. He was discharged in San Francisco on March 17, 1969.

Tom returned to civilian status and became a member of the Brentwood Police Force and then joined the U.S. Treasury Department as a special agent. He served on the Presidential Drug Task Force and was resident agent in-charge for the U.S. Customs Investigations. Tom currently serves on the Board of Directors of Focus Marines Foundation - St. Louis, UMSL – BS Police Administration. and the DePaul – MS Public Administration.

Tom and his wife, Sandi, have been married for 44 years. They have a son, daughter, and two grandchildren.
