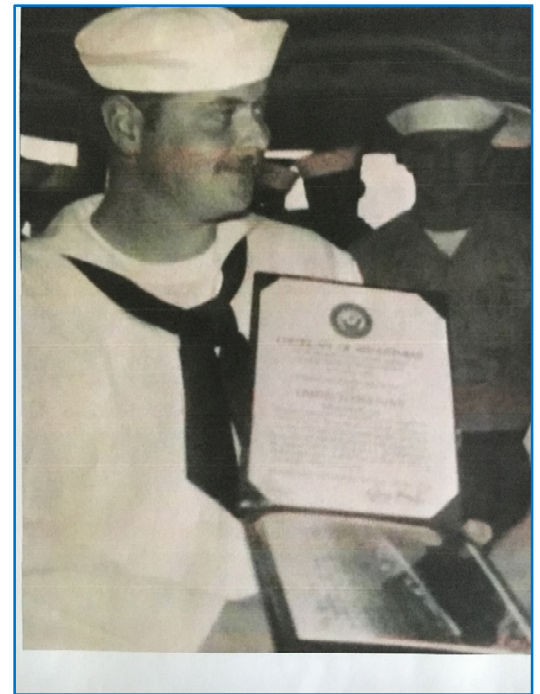

Timothy entered the United States Navy in 1981 completing boot camp in San Diego, CA. He was assigned to USS *New Jersey* (BB 62) which served troops in WWII, the Korean War and the Vietnam War. Timothy was assigned to the recommissioning crew earning the distinction of being a 'plankowner'. Upon reenlisting in 1985 he served as a guard at the Naval Consolidated Brig Charleston, SC. In 1988 he was assigned to USS *Lamoure County* (LST 1194) which was sent to the Arabian Gulf. He became the leading signalman and chief master of arms responsible for 350 sailors and 900 marines. He was on duty in 1983 during the bombing of the marine barracks in Beirut, Lebanon.

During his decade of service, Timothy received the Navy Achievement Medal, two Navy Good Conduct Medals, National Defense Medal, Navy Expediency Medal, Kuwait Liberation Medal and Southwest Asian Campaign Medal.

After Timothy's service, He worked in the trucking industry for 20 years before becoming a transportation team leader for a major heating and air conditioning company. He is an active member of the Ancient Order of Hibernians and is involved with his local AMVETS.
