Christina enlisted in the United States Air Force in 1996. She completed basic training at Lackland Air Force Base, TX. Additional duty stations were Hickam Air Force Base, HI and Australia, where she worked as a signals intelligence analyst.

For her service, Christina was awarded three Joint Service Achievement Medals and a Joint Service Commendation Medal. She achieved Operator of the Quarter in Hawaii and multiple Operator of the Month certificates. She graduated with honors from basic Morse Code training and was awarded the Samuel F.B. Morse award.



One memorable event stands out to Christine. "It was during a color guard event I participated in while stationed in San Antonio. It was a Veteran's Day event in Fredericksburg, TX. It was windy during the service with guest speakers from WWII and the flag I was holding knocked my hat off my head. I maintained my military bearing, standing at attention, and after the veteran finished speaking, he walked over and put my hat back on my head.
