Following basic training at Camp Roberts, CA, he was assigned to Kadena Air Base, Okinawa, Korea with the 22nd AAA Artillery Battalion working as a wire fieldman. Cpl. Jeude was honorably discharged from Ft. Carson, CO in October, 1954.

In civilian life, Bill was a full time carpenter, proudly building over 200 homes. He and his wife, Elaine, have two children. Bill continues to be active with the Korean War Veterans Association, donating to the local food pantry and assisting with other charitable needs in his local area.
