Robert C. Wade enlisted in the United States Air Force in 1966, completing basic training at Lackland Air Force Base, TX and technical training at Chanute Air Force Base, IL. Trained as a jet mechanic, Robert was assigned to Royal Air Force Station Lakenheath, England.

Robert modestly says he earned the "standard citations" for his service. He fondly remembers having the opportunity to travel while stationed in England, visiting London, travelling to Europe, driving across Germany and attending the Grand National Steeple Chase. The best advice he received was "Don't volunteer for anything!". Robert was honorably discharged in 1970.
