Adrian Stopke enlisted in the United States Navy in April 1990, completing basic training at Naval Air Station Great Lakes, IL, and additional training at Operations Specialists "A" School in VA. He was assigned to USS *Belknap* (CG 26). Following his honorable discharge in 1994, Adrian served in the Naval Reserves from 1997-2004, with duty stations in Italy, South Korea, Bahrain and Kuwait.

Adrian received numerous medals, ribbons and citations for his service including Navy/Marine Corps Achievement Medal, Meritorious Unit commendation, Navy Reserve Meritorious Service Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Southwest Asia Service Medal Iraq, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Sea Service Deployment Ribbon and Rifle Marksmanship Medal.
