Mr. Stankovich was drafted into the United States Army in the final years of the Vietnam War, being sworn in on March 2, 1970. After going through boot camp at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri he was transferred to Fort Story, Virginia with the 329th Transportation Company. He then spent time in the Republic of Vietnam and ended his service days with the 138th Infantry Division at Jefferson Barracks, Missouri.

Craig drove and operated amphibious vehicles, trucks, jeeps and an armored personnel carrier field hospital. For his service, he was awarded the Vietnam Service Medal and the Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal.

His most memorable experience and remembrance was visiting the Gold Buddha and the beautiful architecture in Thailand while on R&R.

His advice to the younger generation: Keep your head down.

He and his wife Debbie have been married for 47 years and have a son and daughter plus two grandsons and two granddaughters
