David Frederick "Fred" Lovercamp**



Fred Lovercamp served his country from 1942 to 1945 in the US Navy aboard the USS Massachusetts. His unit was in the Pacific Theater and participated in the Philippine Liberation. For this service he received a total of 12 Battle Stars.

When he returned stateside, he completed his education and taught in the Sedalia school system for over 25 years. He also taught at State Fair Community College. As a science teacher, he helped countless numbers of students with their science fair projects and oratorical contests. Fred was a 4-H leader for 10 years and President of the Missouri Pork Association for 2 years. He is a member of American Legion Post 279 at Sweet Springs, MO; VFW Post 5651 at Sweet Springs; and VFW Post 2591 at Sedalia. He is a member of the Lutheran Church.

Fred is now 86 years young and is not in good health. He is married to Waunita and they have two sons, who are both educators. They have eight grandchildren. Waunita is a member of the Osage Chapter.

Fred was always willing to help the Chapter with parade floats, nametags, coasters, drawings, and has made hundreds of nut cups.
