Tim volunteered and entered the United States Army in April 1967. His basic training was at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. He was transferred to Fort Lee, Virginia where he attended cooking school. He took advanced infantry and security training at Fort Campbell, Kentucky.

In the Republic of Vietnam from 1967 to 1969, Tim did radio research for the Army Security Agency. He finished his military service in 1970 at Vint Hill Farm Station, Warrenton, Virginia. He earned the rank of Specialist 5.
