Lt Col Robert Bryant serves our country in the United States Air Force. As a career officer he has served since May of 1996 and has accumulated 3900 hours in numerous aircraft including the T-37, T-6A, T-38, and F-15E. He has been stationed around the world: Lakenheath, UK; Seymour Johnson AFB, North Carolina; Vance AFB, Oklahoma; Randolph AFB, Texas; Ft. Leavenworth, Kansas; and the Pentagon. He has served in the following positions: Command Pilot, Evaluator Pilot, Instructor Pilot, and Squadron Commander. He was twice deployed for Operation Iraqi Freedom and once for Operation Enduring Freedom. His medals, decorations, and awards number twenty-nine including the Meritorious Service Medal, Air Force Outstanding Unit Award with Valor Device, the Iraq Campaign Medal, and the Afghanistan Campaign Medal.

Lt Col Bryant is married with four children and a foster son. His wife, Melissa, is an Air Force veteran. They are both graduates of the United States Air Force Academy.
