COL Paul S. Brown, Jr., MD, FACS graduated from St. Louis University High School in May 1972, St. Louis University in May 1971 and St. Louis University Medical School in May 1986. He completed his residency in general surgery at Northwestern University in Chicago in 1993, and in that same year he joined the Army Reserve Medical Corp as a captain. He completed thoracic surgery residency at the University of Pennsylvania in 1996. Dr. Brown completed officer basic and officer advanced schools at Fort Sam Houston. He was assigned to Tripler Army Medical Center, Honolulu, Hawaii, from 1993-2005 and Ft. Benning from 2005 to the current date. COL Brown was recently awarded the Army Medical Corps Proficiency "A" Designator Award in Cardiothoracic Surgery and is currently a cardiothoracic surgeon in Lancaster, Pennsylvania. COL Brown was called to active service in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom.

COL Brown is a member of the Sons of the American Revolution. He has two children, and his son is an artillery officer in the United States Marines.
