Gary Lee served in the U.S Army from 1967 to 1970 as a helicopter and track vehicle mechanic. He was stationed at Ft. Leonard Wood, Missouri, Ft. Eustis, Virginia, Ft. Knox, Kentucky, Camp Enari, Vietnam and Ft. Hood, Texas. For his service Gary received the National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal with 4 Bronze Service Stars, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, Aircraft Crewman Badge and Sharpshooter (Rifle) Badge.

In his civilian career, Gary also served as a mechanic in retail applications. Gary is an active member of the Twin Oaks FWB Church and the VFW. He has been a long time member of the Madison County Historical Society and currently serves as president of the society. Gary and his wife, Barbara, have two sons and three grandchildren.
