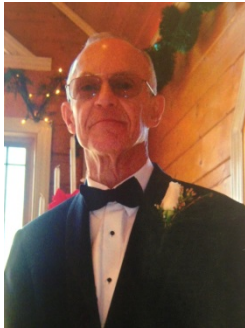

James Daniel Gilbert served as a Senior airman (SrA) from 1966 to 1970 in the U.S. Air Force. He entered the service in Kansas City, Missouri. From there he went to Wichita, Kansas, McConnell Air Field as security with the Titan II missiles. Then he went to the Philippines for two years as Intelligence and Renaissance. He was also stationed in Rapid City, South Dakota. He was honorably discharged in Rapid City, South Dakota, in the spring of 1970.

His civilian career has included real estate brokerage and construction, as well as reserve police officer work for eleven years. At the same time, he worked with Christian Foundation for Children and Aging, including a year in Guatemala. He has participated in walks for humanities.
