The Gilead Rupe Chapter proudly presents Glenn Dennis of Odessa, Missouri, for Patriot of the Month.

Glenn enlisted in the U.S. Army at Ft. Leavenworth, Kansas, on August 3, 1944. He was in the Infantry with duty in Europe. On January 3, 1945, he was wounded in the battle at Junglinster, Luxembourg, and earned a Purple Heart. Glenn also received the Good Conduct Medal and the European-African-Middle Eastern Campaign Medal. He received an honorable discharge from the Army in July of 1946 as a PFC. As a civilian, Glenn farmed and worked for Allis-Chalmers combine manufacturing plant in Independence, Missouri, for thirty years.

Glenn is a proud veteran. He is active in his local VFW. On July 4, 2015, he participated in a panel discussion of World War II for the local historical society. He was in the community parade on August 8, 2015, commemorating our local veterans. On October 6, 2015, Glenn was part of the Heartland Honor Flight to Washington, D.C. It was truly one of the most memorable experiences of his life, and he proudly wears the t-shirt he received on this trip.

Glenn Dennis proudly served his country in World War II and continues to be involved in his community and church activities.
