Scott received the Meritorious Service Medal twice; the Army Commendation Medal twice; Army Achievement Award six times; Volunteer Service Award; Overseas Ribbon; National Defense Medal; Joint Meritorious Ribbon; Humanitarian Ribbon; Expert Field Medical Badge; U.S. Airborne Wings; British Airborne Wings; and the Gold German Efficiency Badge.
