Kenneth "Ken" Sellers (USAF, Ret.)

Ken joined the Army Air Corp right after graduation from high school in 1943. His 403rd Bomb Squadron was attached to the 5th Air Force. He was an aerial gunner on a B-24. Their unit flew 55 missions in the Philippines, the Dutch East Indies, and Australia against the Japanese.

When Ken was discharged in 1945, he returned home and attended Chillicothe Business College at Chillicothe, MO. He went to work for the Frisco Railroad as secretary to the General Agent based in Joplin.



He married Nadine Crabb, whom he described as "the best wife and mother, an excellent cook and baker." They have one married daughter and two grandchildren.

Now 78 years old, Ken has resided at the Missouri Veterans Home at Mt. Vernon for almost 3 years. He is respected by staff and residents alike.
