He served in Japan, Alaska, California, Maryland, North Carolina, Florida, Midway Island, Canada, Guam, the Panama Canal, and the Philippines.

Jerry was awarded the Navy Occupation Service Medal with Asia Clasp, Korean Service Medal, the United Nations Service Medal, a Navy Unit Commendation, Navy Achievement Medal, and the Naval Security Group Meritorious Service Award.

After his retirement he helped set up a museum on the base in Pensacola. Jerry is a member of the Catholic Church, Veterans of Foreign Wars, and the Elks Club.
