He has completed a nine month-tour to Afghanistan where he served as Veterinary Corps Officer for the Georgia NG Agribusiness Development Team (ADI) III. His service was centered assisting an Afghan District with Irrigation and Livestock Directors, para-veterinarians, and local farmers with livestock needs.

For his service, Major Johnson has been awarded the Bronze Star, Afghanistan Campaign Medal, Army Commendation Medal, National Defense Service Medal (and award), Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Armed Forces Reserve Medal, Army Service Ribbon, NATO Medal, and Parachutist Badge.

In civilian life, Eugene owns and operates a mobile veterinary clinic. He and his wife, Kaye Johnson, DVM, have two daughters. They attend the Catholic Church and are members of the American Veterinary Medical Association.
