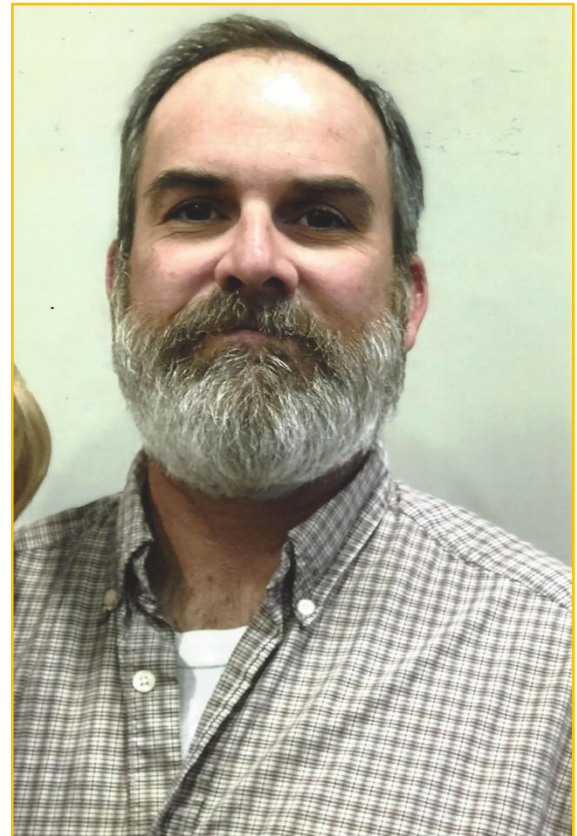

Bryan entered the United States Army in October, 1988. He was trained in Military Police. He was assigned to the 2nd Infantry Division, Camp Pelham, South Korea and the 980th Military Police Company, Sierra Army Depot, California. He left active duty in 1992.

In September, 2001, Bryan joined the Missouri National Guard. He was assigned to the 1139th Military Police Company, Harrisonville. Later he transferred to the 110th Maneuver Enhancement Brigade, Kansas City, Missouri and the 110th. He was deployed to Iraq twice during this period. Bryan retired from the National Guard in September, 2017.

Medals from his deployments to the Iraq Campaign are: Iraq Campaign Medal w/one star; Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Campaign Ribbon, and two Army Commendation Medals.

Bryan received the Humanitarian Medal for his deployment to Louisiana during the Katrina Hurricane.
