Michael entered the United States Army in August 1966 and attended basic training at Ft. Leonard Wood, MO. Advanced Individual Training was at Ft. Benjamin Harrison, IN. Additional duty stations included Riverdale, MD, Ft. Meade, MD, St. Louis, MO and the Pentagon. While assigned in St. Louis, Michael was Division Chief for the Combat Support Division. While at the Pentagon, he managed education and incentives to include the GI Bill. His final assignment was Reserve Component Personnel Policy Integrator.
