Wynn entered the United States Army in 1953 at St. Louis, MO. He was assigned to the 3rd Battalion, Company B, 17th Medium Tank Battalion, 7th Armored Division at Camp Roberts, CA for basic training. He was assigned to the Classification and Assignments Department as a clerk typist. Additional duty stations included Ft. Lewis, WA.

The most interesting sight of his military career were the parade fields at Camp Roberts, CA. Twelve hundred men could pass review at one time. Corporal Melton was honorably discharged from service in February 1955.

During his civilian career, Wynn was an office manager, buyer and materials handler for several companies. He is a member of the Knights of Columbus, American Legion, Korean Veterans Chapter and volunteers for hospice and his local church food pantry.
