Jason entered the United States Coast Guard in 1994 assigned to USCGC *Sumac (WLR 311)* until 1996. He was then assigned to the Marine Safety Office in Toledo, OH until his honorable discharge in 2001. Jason requested active duty recall and was reactivated as a U.S. Navy Chaplain in 2012. He is currently assigned to the 7th Regiment Marines in California.

As Chaplain, Jason has felt the joy of leading people to safety through suicide intervention, as well as the sorrow of standing with families grieving the loss of fallen soldiers. His most rewarding aspect of serving as a U.S. Navy Chaplain is talking to young people who are at the cross roads of crisis and mentoring them through it. The best advice he has received is "Start where you are. Use what you have. Do what you can."
