Joseph was commissioned as general medical officer in Syracuse in 1981 and immediately entered flight surgery training. He received his Flight Surgeon Badge as a flight surgeon in 1983 and retired as Chief Flight Surgeon in 2013. As flight surgeon he was the primary care physician for a variety of military aviation personnel on special duty status, such as pilots, flight officers, navigators/combat systems officers, astronauts, and air traffic controllers.

During his service, Joseph earned several awards and citations including two Air Medals, Aerial Achievement Award, Air Force Commendation Medal, Presidential Unit Citation for Valor, Iraqi Service Medal and Afghan Service Medal.

In civilian life, Joseph is an orthopedic surgeon, member of the Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons and belongs to the American Society of the Hand. Locally he is a member of the Masonic Lodge and the Shrine Club. He is married and has one step-daughter.
