William Rynecki enlisted in the United States Air Force in June 1976, completing basic training at Lackland AFB, TX. During his 29 year career his duty stations were numerous and included Ft. Benjamin Harrison, IN, Elmendorf AFB, AK, Maxwell, AFB, AL, Santiago, Chile, and Manta, Ecuador.

For his service William received numerous medals, ribbons and citations including the Meritorious Service Medal, Air Force Longevity Service Award with 4 oak leaf clusters, Global War on Terrorism Medal and Air Force Outstanding Unit Award with one oak leaf cluster.

In civilian life, Colonel Rynecki drives a bus for disabled students, volunteers for the Belleville and St. Clair County Historical Societies as well as Jazz St. Louis and First Night Grand Center. He is a member of the Retired Officers Association and Alumni of Department of History Facility, US Air Force Academy, CO. He has two children.
