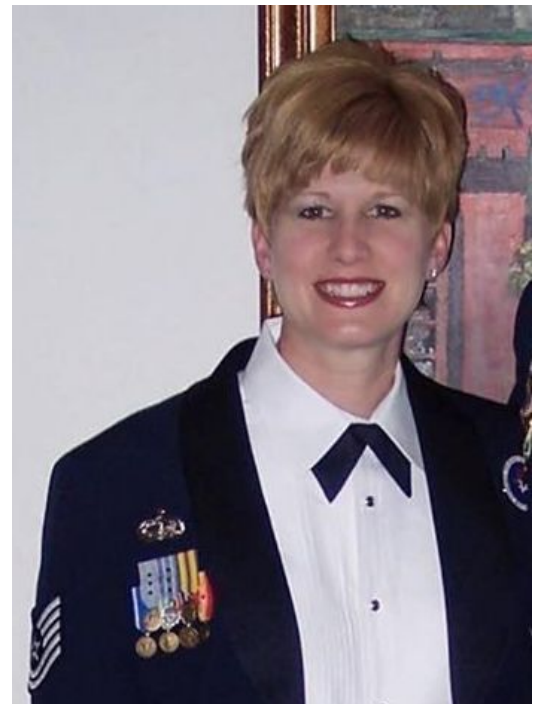

Stacie Campbell enlisted in the United States Air Force in June 1992. Duty stations included Germany, Cheyenne, WY, United Kingdom, South Korea and California. Her career field was Services, which included Lodging, Fitness, Dining facility/Flight Kitchen and Mortuary Affairs and as a Services Career Field Instructor.

She was awarded the Meritorious Services Medal, Air Force Commendation Medal (x4), Air Force Achievement Medals (x5), Meritorious Unit Award, Outstanding Unit Award (x12), Good Conduct Medal (x7), National Defense Services Medal w/1 Service Star, Global War on Terrorism Services Medal, Korean Services Medal, Armed Forces Services Medal, NATO Medal, Air Force Expeditionary Services Ribbon.



Some of the most interesting experiences Stacie had while in the service was traveling in 1993 to Berlin for New Year's. In 2010 she took people around Saddam Hussein's Al-Faw-Palace in Iraq. In 2012 she was able to visit the DMZ and see the tunnel the North Koreans had dug out when stationed in South Korea. The best of advice she received was to lead by example. Your people need to know that you are not afraid to do the same tasks with them. Respect them and they will respect you.
