Mr. Harding served in the Army Reserves from September 11, 1981 until September 2007 and attained the rank of Major. His active duty tours were: January to June 1995; March to September 1998 and May to November 2003.



Mr. Harding was in the Army Reserves for 27 years. He was deployed to Panama in 1995; Bosnia in 1998; The Philippines in 2000 and 2001; and Kosovo in 2002. He served in Field Artillery for ten years and in Public Affairs for seventeen years. During his last four years, he was an instructor at Army Public Affairs School, Ft. Mead, MD.

Mr. Harding has many interests and is involved with many groups. These include him serving as Vice-President of the Jefferson Barracks Chapter of the Company of Military Historians and as a member of the 2nd US Regiment of Artillery. He is also is a certified weapons expert.
