Glenn Clarence Fischer was drafted in the United States Army on March 26, 1969. Following basic training at Fort Leonard Wood, MO, he was assigned to Fort Lewis, Washington for Infantry 11 Bravo. This is an important role in the U.S. Army as they are responsible for defending the country through real-life combat. From there he was sent to Fort Benning, GA, and then Fort Riley, Ks.



Glenn was in the 101st Airborne at Camp Eagle, located southeast of Hue in Central Vietnam. When asked about his time in the service, he remembered mostly the camaraderie among the young men that he served with. He said that they were there to support each other with a common goal to serve their country.

"As an E-5, I felt a deep responsibility to protect my men while leading them," he said. The best advice he received in the service was to keep your head down!

The following ribbons, medals or citations Glenn received were Expert on M-14 and M-16, Expert on M-79 Combat Infantry Badge, Air Medal, and E-5 Medal.

Before being drafted, he worked for McDonald Douglas in receiving and shipping.

Presently he belongs to various community organizations including Missouri Amvets, American Legion, and Veteran of Foreign Wars.

He is a car enthusiast and has a great interest in Muscle Cars. The Britannica Dictionary describes them as "American-made two-door sports cars with a powerful engine." He proudly said that he still races his Chevy Nova, which is a small automobile manufactured by Chevrolet. Therefore, it is no surprise that he belongs to the Show Me Car Club.
