Haley Robinette Gilland was born in Fort Riley, Kansas in 1996. She is the daughter of Retired U.S. Army Colonel James H. Robinette, II and Carol Anne (Burton) Robinette. She graduated from Episcopal High School in Alexandria, Virginia, in 2014 and graduated from the United States Military Academy at West Point in 2018. While at West Point, Haley was a member of the lacrosse team, strength team, Society of Women Engineers, was the secretary for the Cadet Honor Committee, and served as a summer intern in Washington, D.C., for the Women In Military Service for America. Haley's family has served in the Army dating back to the American Revolution. "The Army is definitely 'the family business' in a sense. Growing up as a military brat, I was afforded a unique childhood, so I always wanted to give back to an organization that

gave so much to me as a child." Haley's brother, Zachary Robinette, currently serves in the United States Air Force as a KC-46 pilot.

- Human Resources Manager, 3<sup>rd</sup> Brigade, 101<sup>st</sup> Airborne Division, Fort Campbell, Kentucky (to include a nine-month deployment to northeastern Europe, near the Russian border, to deter Russian aggression against Baltic allies).

Her awards include the Army Commemoration Medal (with 3 Oak Leaf Clusters), the Army Achievement Medal (with 3 Oak Leaf Clusters), the National Defense Service Medal, the Global War on Terror Service Medal, the Korean Defense Service Medal, the Overseas Service Ribbon (2 awards), the Air Assault Badge, and the German Armed Forces Proficiency Badge in gold.

Haley is married to Alex Gilland, a 2019 graduate of the United States Military Academy at West Point. They are both currently assigned to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Brigade of the 101<sup>st</sup> Airborne Division at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, where Alex is a company commander. Haley is a recent graduate of the United States Army Air Assault School and will assume company command in the spring of 2025.
